



The Oxford and Cambridge Boat Race is one of the oldest sporting events in the world. The 162nd race will be held this year on March 27th with both the Women's Boat Race and the Men's Boat Race being rowed on the Thames. The scores since the races first began in 1829 (men) and 1927 (women) now stand at:

Men: Oxford 79 : Cambridge 81

Women: Oxford 29 : Cambridge 41

We are again joining forces with the boat club in Muiden and setting up a large screen with satellite TV link in order to watch both races, followed by a buffet dinner.
