The Oxford and Cambridge Boat Race is one of the oldest sporting events in the world and presents a key element in our Society's events program. The 164th race will be held this year on Saturday, March 24th with both the Women's Boat Race and the Men's Boat Race being rowed on the Thames. The scores now stand at:

Men: Oxford 80 : Cambridge 82

Women: Oxford 30 : Cambridge 42



This year our traditional boat race dinner will be held at the royal boat club in Heemstede. We will be watching the races on a large TV screen, followed by a three-course sit-down dinner.
